Patty Carey '87 is the writer and creator of *Half Life*, a single camera comedy starring Larisa Oleynik (*The Secret World of Alex Mack*, *10 Things I hate about You*, *Mad Men*.) *Half Life* was produced after winning the #GreenLightHer screenwriting competition, the City of New York Mayor's Office of Media and Entertainment's (MOME) groundbreaking initiative designed to highlight and address the underrepresentation of women in the film and television industry. The pilot episode aired on NYC Life, the city's official broadcast network with a reach of 18 million households with four more episodes scheduled to air in 2019. In addition to writing, Patty has over 20 years of experience working in feature film and television production as a top location manager and scout. Her location department credits include the pilot episode of HBO's *Succession* directed by Oscar winner Adam McKay, 20th Century Fox's *The Greatest Showman* starring Hugh Jackman, Marvel Studios' *Doctor Strange*, Jerry Bruckheimer's *The Sorcerer's Apprentice*, and Ron Howard's Oscar winning *A Beautiful Mind*. She is a member of the Directors Guild of America and has a B.S. in Journalism from the University of Maryland. She lives in Manhattan with her husband and two children. *Half Life* is not autobiographical – Patty's kids eat school lunch!
