dear parents, alumni and  
friends of st. rose high school,

I hope that you enjoyed your summer and spent many happy days with family and friends. It is hard to believe, but we are already experiencing the chill of Autumn and soon will be enjoying its beauty.

Our students and staff enjoyed a historic opening to the new school year. For almost 10 decades, St. Rose High School students followed a traditional eight-period day schedule, including seven classes and lunch. After two years of research and studying various scheduling options, the Learning Innovations Team recommended the implementation of a “Four-Day Rotating Drop Schedule.” The transition to the new schedule in September was flawless and the schedule was well received by students and staff. The benefits of the schedule include: extended class time, one additional class per year for students, built-in tutorial time, and an expanded curriculum.

As mentioned, a by-product of the new schedule is an expanded curriculum. Since students are now taking eight classes as opposed to seven classes with the prior schedule, elective course offerings needed to be available for all students. Music and drama classes are now offered along with new electives in business and social studies. “Project Acceleration” – a collaboration with Seton Hall University – is offering a college credit class in education.

School Security and Safety, Accountability and Communication Initiatives have also been implemented. “Wave Plus” allows the school to communicate with the Belmar Police and their patrol cars via radio communication using a pre-recorded message should an emergency situation occur at the school. Swipe K12 takes

attendance through a swipe system and allows school personnel to know where students are located throughout the school day. Arrival and departure text messages are also sent to parents. Finally, a St. Rose High School App allows for open communication and information to be shared among parents, teachers, administrators, and coaches.

Morning Convocation is in its second year at the high school. Convocation focuses on spirituality, academics, athletics, student activities and acknowledgement. Convocation is student driven and is live streamed every morning.

The year also began by welcoming the Class of 2023 – our “Centennial Class.” In 2023, St. Rose High School will be celebrating its 100th year. Celebrations are being planned and the focus will include the rich history and tradition of St. Rose High School – the oldest Catholic secondary school in the Trenton Diocese. This year’s theme, “The Past, Present and Future” will be reflected throughout the centennial celebrations.

Our goals and mission as a secondary Catholic school are crystal clear. We want to provide our students with a meaningful, spiritual experience through liturgies, retreats, community service, religious studies and daily prayer. Our academics are rigorous, relevant and meaningful, and are complemented with a comprehensive and competitive athletic program, whose core beliefs are based

on values, integrity and respect. An array of clubs and activities also are available to the students, and the newly formed St. Rose Theater Company produces a Fall Drama and Spring Musical. All shows are now presented at the Spring Lake Community House.

I hope I updated you on “What’s New” at St. Rose High School. None of our accomplishments would be possible without the ongoing support of our parents, alumni and friends. As I begin my third year as principal, I want you to know that I feel blessed to be able to serve our students, their families, and the entire St. Rose Family. And, I am truly thankful for all that you do for the students and the future of our school.

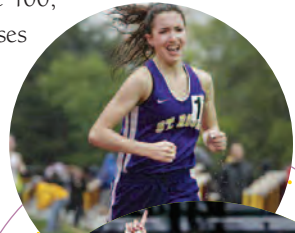

#### Abby Antognoli • Track and Field

Abby has been a force on the track and field teams since her freshman year when she won the 400, 800, 1600 and 3200 at the outdoor North Public B South State Sectional meet in 2018. She came back to win the 400, 800, and 1600 at the NPB State group meet a week later. She was awarded Shore Track Coaches Athlete of the Year for 2018. This past 2019 season, she was the Shore Conference Champion in the 1600, and repeated as the State Sectional Champion in the 800, 1600, and 3200. She placed 2nd in the 400, scoring the team leading 38 points and leading the Purple Roses to a third place overall finish. At the state group meet, she placed first in the 1600 and 3200, and second in the 400 and 800 and advanced individually to the NJSIAA Meet of Champions. You might not be fast enough to catch Abby on the track, but you can always come and see her on the basketball court where she also shines as an important member of our winning girls' team!



#### Julianne Leskauskas #8 • Soccer

Jules not only works hard in the classroom and in the community, but has spent the last 14 years honing her soccer skills. Along with those skills, she brings the drive and competitive spirit of a champion to everything she does. Jules has been invited to the US National Team camps for four years and was named Best 11 in both the girl's soccer Development Academy and the ESNL National Cup. Beyond being named All Division for the St. Rose Purple Roses, and 3rd team All-State, Jules was also named the Coast Star's Athlete of the Season for Soccer. As a junior, Jules committed to Rutgers University, and as a senior, she is now leading the Purple Roses to another outstanding soccer season. Her sense of teamwork, her work ethic and her effervescent personality make her a beloved member of the Purple Roses squad and of the entire SRHS community.

#### Sean Donohue • Cross Country

Sean Donohue is a four year member of the cross country and track teams, and is this year's co-captain. He is a clear team leader and his accomplishments are indicative of his hard work. # st. rose connections

There's something special about St. Rose alumni and the SRHS community. Here are just a few examples of what it means to be part of the family.



## TOGETHER AGAIN... FOR THE FIRST TIME

Joined by a shared mission, two friends reunite for St. Rose students. When Chris Dayton and Nick Petrillo met at St. Mary's Seminary six years ago both men were fairly certain about where they were headed. They shared the same desire to serve others and to spread the word of God, as well as a belief that they had been called upon for this important work. Little did they know then that they would take such different paths to reach the same destination.

In 2013, Nick Petrillo was one year ahead of the newly arrived Chris Dayton at St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore. The two men quickly became friends and shared many of the same experiences as young seminarians. When Nick left a year later to get married it might have seemed that their friendship would end – but their connection was strong, so they kept in touch. In fact, Chris served as a Deacon at Nick's wedding. Even though Nick had chosen to pursue a life outside the priesthood, his passion to be involved in Catholic ministry was still as present as ever, and he and Chris still shared a strong bond from their days at the seminary.

As a newly ordained priest, and the School Chaplain at St. Rose, Fr. Chris knew that Nick would be a perfect fit as the St. Rose Campus Minister. He knew that Nick believed as he did that it was essential to instruct young people about integrating faith into every aspect of their lives. He knew that together they could help them see its influence, presence and effects. When the position of Campus Minister became open, Fr. Chris reached out. Now the two friends are together again working to bring the power of our faith to St. Rose students.

And... they have big plans. Whether it was luck, or fate, or divine inspiration that brought Nick and Fr. Chris together again we will never know – but we do know that our students will benefit from their shared perspective.

He also committed himself to getting to know as many of the seniors as he could; coming to senior events, and taking the time out of his busy schedule to talk with members of the Class of 2019. His message to the seniors at graduation was inspirational and accessible, and was overwhelmingly well received by the graduates and everyone else in attendance.

Jason appreciates the importance of a St. Rose education, and has been "paying it forward" to help deserving students attend SRHS because he himself had been the recipient of an anonymous donor that enabled him to stay at St. Rose .

The generosity that was shown to Jason in his junior year had a tremendous impact on him, and although he has never known the identities of the people who helped him, he has never forgotten their kindness. Because of their example, Jason and his wife Carla have given every year to help struggling families send, or keep, their children at St. Rose.

This spring Jason received a short note that brought tears to his eyes and renewed his belief in the value of paying it forward. Just one sheet of paper in his mailbox reminded him, and all of us, that the good we do in this world extends into the future in ways we can not predict.
