boys finished the season undefeated in Shore Conference play while advancing to the finals of the modified NJSIAA Central East Non-Public Tournament.




Boys Golf

During the regular season the boys won all of their matches finishing 14-0, continuing to dominate the B-Central division. They put up a strong performance in the Shore Conference Tournament at Charleston Springs Golf Course with an 8th place team finish and Jacob Capone '21 finishing 10th as an individual. The boys went on to handily win the Non-Public B South state tournament as a team led by Jacob Capone '21, (2nd), Liam Donnelley '22, (6th), and Michael Fluhr '21, (9th). They went on to perform admirably in the NJSIAA Tournament of Champions against a highly competitive field, finishing #22 as a team.







Girls Basketball

Winter sports during the 2020-21 school year were impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic perhaps more than any other season. Despite many changes and interruptions due to the pandemic, the girls basketball team under coach Mary Beth Chambers put together yet another solid season, finishing the year 11-4. Abby Antognoli '21 scored her 1,000th point in March during a game against Wall where the Purple Roses cruised to an



83-33 win. Abby is currently playing NCAA Division I basketball at Lafayette University. Also currently competing at the collegiate level are Maureen Stapleton '21 at Stone Hill College and Layla Laws '21 at St. Francis University. The Roses look to bounce back during the 2021-22 season led by returning starters Rosie Scognamiglio '23, who has committed to Bucknell University, and Maggie Cavanaugh '23 who has committed to the University of New Hampshire.

native who played for national powerhouse and perennial championship contender Villanova, After Villanova, Brian played professionally throughout Europe in Poland, Israel, Portugal, Greece, Germany, Italy, France, and Belgium. Upon finishing his playing career, Brian spent 9 years coaching professionally in Belgium where he coached domestically and internationally with the FIBA Europe and Champions League. Brian has returned home after 20 years of professional basketball in Europe to coach locally and took the reins of the St. Rose High School boys' basketball program this fall. Brian is replacing Coach Frank Carmody '75 who will remain as an advisor to the program with a focus on alumni involvement and support.

St. Rose is thrilled to have Coach Lynch join our storied boys' basketball program and looks forward to its continued growth and success.

Boys Lacrosse

The boys lacrosse squad put together a great run during the spring season. Led by head coach Jeff Rosenberg and assistant coaches Ryan Hilla and Anthony LaTesta the boys consistently showed that they were in the mix as one of the top ten teams in the Shore Conference. The Roses finished the season 14-6 and notched victories in the first round of the Shore Conference and NJSIAA Non-Public B state tournaments. Their fourteen wins are the most by a St. Rose boys lacrosse team in at least a decade. Outstanding performances by Logan LeMoult '21, Brendan Dwyer '21, Colin Westhoven '22 and Max MacEachern '21 fueled their success. LeMoult led the team with 58 goals and 23 assists (81pts), Dwyer scored 45 goals with 24 assists (69pts) and Westhoven scored 30 goals with 16 assists (46pts) while winning 57% of his faceoffs. Max MacEachern led the Shore Conference with 215 saves stopping 61% of shots on goal. In the final Shore Sports Network Top 10 of the season, the boys earned the #10 ranking.

It is realized in the selfless service and generosity of our community and in the talents nurtured in our students. The academic curiosity and grit of our students motivates each of us at SRHS toward positive action.

At St. Rose we inspire one another to be our best, to try harder, to overcome setbacks, and to have a positive impact on each other and the world.

Good Advice •-

You received a pass to see your school counselor – what does that mean? Are you in trouble? Perhaps that would be the case at other schools, but not at St. Rose. The guidance department here strives to empower, inspire and motivate our students. From the first appointment in freshman year through the final appointment at the end of senior year, the counselors at St. Rose are continually engaged with students and focused on providing individualized grade-appropriate services. By the time a student begins the post-secondary school search and application process they have spent countless hours with their counselor ensuring that they are getting recommendations from someone who knows them and whose guidance they trust. At St. Rose, the student to counselor ratio is small and students have the same counselor for all four years. This allows for students and counselors to form a true bond where respect and caring are established. We value our guidance department and that commitment guarantees that each student gets a level of personal attention that is not possible at other schools. Visit the guidance suite on any given day, and you will see students stopping by their counselor's office to share a good grade on a test, discuss an upcoming assignment, or ask for help on a college essay. The work of our guidance department also includes spending time with parents, working with them to discuss course selection, answering questions about school related issues, and finally informing them about applying for financial aid and scholarships. On average our graduating seniors each receive \$170,000.00 in scholarships and 90% are accepted by their first choice college. Great outcomes like these are made possible because of the important relationships that have been formed, the knowledge and expertise of our counselors, and the individualized service they provide.

Ingenuity

There is always something exciting going on in Room 505. Here, budding engineers are building bridges, apps, and machines. You can hear the sounds of joy when something works, and see the look of determination to try it another way when something doesn't.

Since initiating this national engineering curriculum four years ago, St. Rose has seen inspiring progress in our students as they learn to see the world around them, and the issues we all face, in new ways.

The Project Lead the Way curriculum has three courses at its core: Introduction to Engineering Design, Principles of Engineering, and Engineering Design and Development. We also offer Civil Engineering and Architecture in junior year. Students who take engineering for all four years of their high school career take EDD in their senior year.

In this capstone year of Engineering Design and Development, students collaborate in teams to engineer a solution to a problem that they identify. During the design process, they research and clearly define the problem then develop and test at least one original solution. Students work closely with outside experts and hone their communication skills as they work.







Last year was the first year of EDD at Saint Rose High School.

Our students worked in teams on five different projects researching existing products and patents, then creating prototypes of their designs. They then presented to a panel of retired engineers and faculty at the Final Design Review.

It was inspiring to see our students use the engineering mindset they had developed over four years, along with the skills they had acquired, to innovate and problem solve.

They learned that research and perseverance are important to success. They utilized collaboration as they "thought outside the box" to address an issue. It gives us hope that these young engineers will continue to use what they learned at St. Rose as they move forward in life.

Motivating students to find solutions, helping them acquire the skills and determination they need to succeed, and celebrating their academic growth and achievement is not only inspiring, but essential.

Real World Skills •

St. Rose students certainly hit the jackpot with Mr. Anthony Attardo leading our Business classes! Anthony had a nearly 30 year career working in the investment industry, including 20 years as a senior Wall Street Analyst. While he had many successes over the course of his career, he has found that it is the failures he experienced that are most important and helpful when teaching lessons in the business classes at St. Rose. The ability to pass on the lessons of "real world" success and failure in his career journey, as well as the stories of the hundreds of companies he used to follow as an analyst, is what inspires him most about teaching the students in the business classes at St. Rose.



In each of the St. Rose business classes, including Accounting, AP Macroeconomics, Economics & Personal Finance, and Stocks, Bonds & Investments, Mr. Attardo incorporates many of the successes and mistakes from his early days and professional investing career to lay the groundwork for how students should evaluate and make smart financial decisions. As a preface to learning about credit card debt, for example, the students discuss how the credit card companies will attack them (as they did with many of us) with high interest cards when they are most vulnerable in their freshman year in college. They discuss why it might make more smart financial sense to buy two year old cars as a preface to learning about depreciation in assets such as automobiles. When learning about career and college choices, Anthony often reflects back to his career covering companies such as Urban Outfitters, who understood the importance of digital marketing early in growing their business and how, as a result, there is a great importance placed on digital marketing majors and careers in corporate America. In accounting, he stresses the importance of financial statements in allowing investors to compare companies and how Wall Street analysts actively use financial statements when they are choosing to invest.

In many of the classes, the students are hearing first-hand experiences Mr. Attardo had from his career as a large investor in companies they have grown to know and love, such as Chipotle, Under Armour, Panera, and Urban Outfitters. Anthony takes the students back to when these companies went public and how their successes and missteps led them to grow into fantastic businesses. In each class, the students participate in a national Stock Market Game, which simulates "real world" investing as the kids are asked to create a portfolio of investments with a hypothetical \$100,000. Each class is divided into teams of four or five participants to compete against other teams in the state and region. Our students are fortunate to incorporate "real world" skills from a professional investor to guide them along. Each team is divided into a portfolio manager, trader, and a team of analysts, which is exactly how the largest investment houses on Wall Street are set up to invest billions of dollars. Importantly, Anthony teaches the students how professionals "invest in good businesses", which is different from "trading in stocks", which can lead to risk. In the end, the kids have a little fun, but they also learn to ask themselves the same questions that analysts on Wall Street ask themselves every day when deciding to invest. Understanding the "right way" to invest and make smart financial decisions has broad implications for the students going forward and we hope this knowledge inspires them to find their own successes and to limit their failures in their journey ahead.

Service

Perhaps the most inspiring aspect of life here at St. Rose is the long history of service and care that the Sisters of St. Joseph have brought into the lives of countless students, and their continued involvement in our school community.

Sr. Marie O'Hagan SSJ reflects on the origins of her order and their continued mission.

Let's imagine it is the year 1650 and you are in LePuy, France, 3,817 miles from the shoreline of Belmar, NJ.

Transported back through time and space you find yourself in a small room, a kitchen, to be exact. The room is simple, sparsely furnished yet feels cozy as it is warmed by a fire in the hearth. Interestingly enough, you are not alone. You are in the company of six French women. You meet 39-year-old Francoise Eyraud, who, even with limited knowledge of the alphabet, is a well experienced administrator of a hospital for orphans. By her side, you encounter Marguerite Bruder, 26-years-old; able to read and in the process of learning how to write. Claudia Chastel, a war widow and the only one of these six women who can both read and write. Anna Brun and Anna Vey make your acquaintance. They are each 15 years of age and both are orphans. Finally, entering the kitchen, is the oldest of the six companions, 46-year-old Anna Chraleyer.

Consider yourself now introduced to the first six Sisters of St. Joseph. Their appearances and their resumes may not impress you, but make no mistake, they were revolutionaries in their day. Up to this time in France the laws of both the church and the civil government bound consecrated religious women to the confines of

a cloistered life. Within the walls of their convents they experienced a fairly regimented life of prayer, all the while being separated from contact with persons in their surrounding communities. Françoise, Marguerite, Claudia, and the three Annas not only longed for a different type of religious life, but with the assistance of their French bishop Henri de Maupas and a Jesuit priest mentor, Jean Pierre Medaille, these women created the Sisters of St. Joseph and brought to birth a new way of being women religious.

The community initiated by Fr. Medaille and referred to as, "The Little Design," grew quickly. The women who joined the original six sisters professed simple vows of chastity, poverty and obedience. Pioneering a new form of religious life, these women desired to openly serve the various needs of their "dear neighbors." Through their apostolic works the sisters were able to respond to situations which they identified as the "miseries," of their day. Be assured the miseries witnessed in 17th France were heart-wrenching ones. The service the sisters provided to ease those miseries reflected the Gospel teaching of the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. Most powerfully, they reflected Jesus' call to, "Love one another as I have

Of course, France was not the only country challenged in addressing the needs of its citizens. Early 20th Century America, enriched by the arrival of numerous immigrants, also faced the awesome task of incorporating them into society. Recognizing education as a key component of this incorporation, the Sisters of St. Joseph, Chestnut Hill responded to this urgent need through the ministry of education. This apostolic work brought the SSJ's to Belmar, New Jersey and the parish of St. Rose. The rest, as they say, is history, or in the case of religious women, "herstory."

Sisters of St. Joseph are familiar with the expression, "A Sister of St. Joseph is about relationships." Perhaps this is one of the reasons why St. Rose High School has become a treasured ministry of our sisters. Anyone familiar with St. Rose could easily attest to the fact that St. Rose is all about relationships too. Perhaps, this gift is the single most important aspect of our beloved school. You, who are presently reading this magazine, know from personal experience the St. Rose relationships which have stood the test of time. In a world all too familiar with disunity, may we never underestimate this unique and powerful gift St. Rose offers to our world.

In our being named after dear Saint Joseph, our Constitutions state, "Our name, Sisters of St. Joseph, reminds us to serve others by our lives with the same care and concern with which Joseph served Jesus and Mary." (#3.) Likewise, "As far as possible we imitate Joseph in the loying manner of his service and his cordial charity to all." (#10.) As you know, Pope Francis named this year as the Year of Joseph. In his proclamation, "Patris Corde," Francis writes about Joseph's privileged vocation as a father to a child not his own. Francis reminds us that Joseph knew his Son belonged to God. In the name of all the sisters who have ministered here at St. Rose, I offer our gratitude for the privilege of caring for children who were not our own. May they always find peace in knowing a closeness with the God who loves them dearly.


> If these past few years have accomplished anything, they have reminded us that our world has its own, "miseries of the day." We do not have to travel far to encounter poverty, homelessness, addictions, lack of proper healthcare, racism, sexism, violence, abuse and hopelessness.

Our "dear neighbors" locally and throughout the world continue to suffer from debilitating inequities, unjust structures, social ills and abandonment. Ever-present to the pain of the world, our God continues to inspire women whose love for the "dear neighbor," ignites within them the desire to not only accompany the "least," of our brothers and sisters but to advocate for the changes needed to create a world community reflecting the ethos of God's beloved community - God's Kingdom.

Three hundred and seventy one years have passed since those six brave women undertook their good works. It may seem as though much has changed since 1650, but upon closer inspection we will recognize that neither our world, nor the basic call to service of a Sister of St. Joseph has fundamentally changed from the need first recognized in 17th century France. The heart of the SSJ remains, "We live and work so that all people may be united with God and with one another."







Generosity

One only has to travel around the buildings at St. Rose, and look at the faces of our students and staff, to see the generosity of our community in action.

It is reflected in the resources, equipment and facility improvements that provide the best learning environment for our students, and in the strength and talents of our student body. Over the years, the alumni, parents and friends of St. Rose have enabled our school and students to thrive, and served as role models of philanthropy and involvement. We find their generosity and the positive impact they have had on the lives of others inspiring.

Scholarships and Financial Aid
