

Dear St. Rose Community:

We are excited to introduce the St. Rose High School mobile app. It is now available in both the [Apple App Store](#) and the [Google Play Store](#).

We are very proud of the team members who worked on this project and are pleased to be delivering you a seamless experience to everything St. Rose. The purpose of this email is to make you aware that the application is available for you to install and to let you know what to expect moving forward.

Over the past two weeks we have been slowly pushing out the app, first to faculty, then students and now to parents. The mobile app is organized into four sections:

- Home
- Calendar
- Groups
- Notifications

When you first open the app it will take you through the setup steps.

1. Choose your role: Student, Parent, Faculty, Community Member
2. Choose the grade levels of your child(ren)
3. Choose their clubs/athletic teams and any activities they are involved in
4. Finally, choose the school wide groups you want to be a part of like PTA, Campus Ministry, Guidance, etc.

The selections you make during the setup process will determine what you see in the app. For example, if your child is not involved in Girls Basketball then you won't be receiving notifications or have access to anything about Girls Basketball. It's also important to note that you can make changes throughout the year. For example, if your child decides to join a new club or play a new sport, then you can go back into the groups and get connected. Finally, my favorite feature is the ability to "search" for what you need. The search bar is on the home screen of the app along with a few buttons for resources, the Daily Announcements, replays of Convocation and the Faculty/Staff directory.

## **EXPECTATIONS & TIMELINE**

We will be training staff and coaches over the next few weeks. Therefore, we will continue to communicate with parents using email and text alerts. We will also be adding those same resources and alerts to the app too. Then, on November 4th, the app will become our primary method of communication. Similarly, all fall sports will continue to maintain their current method of communication and athletics will transition to the mobile app for all communications beginning with the Winter season.
