During the past several months my admiration and respect for the fabric of the St. Rose High School Community has been greatly enhanced. On Friday, March 13, the announcement was made that St. Rose High School would be closing for a two-week period. Never was it anticipated that March 13th would be the final day that the school community would be together for the remainder of the year. However, the resilience of our school community enabled us to successfully complete the school year and remotely provide quality academics for all of our students. The year culminated with a live graduation for the Class of 2020 and a keynote address from James Murray '86, the Director of the United States Secret Service.



The latter months of spring were fraught with uncertainty and hope. Finally, on Friday, June 26, Governor Murphy and Commissioner Repollet announced "The Road Back: Restart and Recovery Plan for Education." Our administrative team then had the framework for developing our plan for reopening St. Rose High School. Together with teachers, board members, parents and administrators, we co-authored a plan that was approved by our administrative team and our St. Rose High School Board. We then shared our plan with our families and faculty, explaining that it was a living document and we encouraged feedback. Finally, our plan was submitted to the Diocese of Trenton and was approved.

Our administrative team and our facilities personnel worked tirelessly to ready our school building for the return of our students. Our goal was to bring as many students back to school in the safest way possible. Space became a priority, and all excess furniture and other items were disposed of or put into storage. Student desks in all classrooms were measured to ensure social distancing. Plexiglass barriers were fabricated for use in the cafeteria and certain classrooms. Signage was installed to direct the flow of student traffic throughout the school building and additional equipment was purchased to enable for the efficiency of cleaning and disinfecting. Though the tasks seemed daunting and the work was exhausting, our team never seemed discouraged. The encouragement and prayers we received from our St. Rose families were truly the inspiration that ensured the success of our team. The greatest moments were yet to come. The smiles on our students' faces (behind their masks!) as they walked into the school building for the first time in six months were priceless. Simply said, it was a thrilling moment to welcome our students back home.

We continue to pray each day for the sustained health and well being of our students, staff, and all of our St. Rose families.






# back in the game

Bob has a decorated resume as both an ice hockey player and coach. He grew up playing hockey for various clubs in northern New Jersey prior to attending Morris Knolls High School and West Chester University where he earned various accol<mark>ade</mark>s and set several team records. After college, he played minor league hockey in the Western Professional Hockey League prior to serving in the United States Navy, where he served as a Surface Warfare Officer aboard the U.S.S. The Sullivans during Operations Noble Eagle and Enduring Freedom. Since 2016, Bob has led Stockton University's ice hockey program to a 39-26-6 record. In 2019-20, he led the program to a national championship appearance and regular season division title. He elevated the program to ACHA Division II status for the 2020-21 season, and was named the DVCHC 2019-20 "Coach of the Year" and is a USA Hockey Certified Level 4 Coach.




..the camaraderie

At the beginning of my senior year, I was very excited for what was to come. I was expecting the first half of the year to be busy with college, and the second half of the year to be full of fun with my friends during our last few months of high school. As we all know, nothing turned out as expected. When we went to online learning, I was not excited, but I do have to admit that the teachers did a great job of keeping all the students engaged and entertained throughout the end of the year.

As I start my freshman year of college, I'm beginning to realize that there are a lot of aspects of St. Rose that I'm going to really miss. From the people that I met, to the games that I attended, St. Rose helped me create amazing memories and grow as a person. I'll forever be thankful to the St. Rose community for shaping me into the person I am today.

Like many others, I welcomed

the start of January with the hope and optimism only the arrival of a new year and decade could bring. I was ready for a fresh start and looked forward to all the changes 2020 had to promise. The biggest change came right in January when I accepted and started a new nursing position closer to my home. I started at an outpatient surgery clinic, which would allow me to have a regular schedule as opposed to working overnights at a hospital an hour away. I was looking forward to having more time off, and more time at home with my husband and come March I had adjusted very nicely to this new normal. Little did I know, this would be the last days of

While life went on as usual for the next few weeks in my new job, once the virus was detected in the United States and began its spread, we all knew nothing would be the same. On March 16th, we sat down for one last meeting together as a group and we were told the office was going to be closed starting March 18th to coincide with the state lockdown. We were to clean the office, take inventory of our products, and prepare for a two week closure of the office.

I also got the opportunity to see people from different walks of life come together to leave this world a little better and a little brighter.

As our shutdown went from two weeks to indefinite, we all received a furlough letter and I, like every other American, desperately began applying for unemployment while searching for another nursing job. Every day was filled with uncertainty and dread and the longer we stayed isolated from family and friends, receiving little news from work, the more I stressed about the future. I talked every day with my parents and siblings, but nothing could ease the discomfort I felt at being at home and without work. Hearing from my college roommate, who is a nurse, as well and my sister, who is a social worker in the hospital, discussing the horrors being seen and all the work they were doing, I began to feel useless

and staying at home, I knew that I had more to offer. After four weeks of shutdown with no end

being a nurse without a job. While I knew

I was doing my part by wearing my mask

in sight, no answer from unemployment, and feelings of just hopelessness taking over, I received an email regarding a job at a field hospital being constructed in the Meadowland Expo Center. While the email was vague, just stating medical personnel was needed for non-COVID-19 patient overflow, I was desperate to be more active in this fight. On April 6th, I reported to the Expo Center at 7 a.m. and toured the facility with all the other nurses, patient care techs, repository therapists, physical therapists, doctors, nurse practitioners, physicians assistants, and all other medical professionals who answered the call. While we were all under the impression that this was non-COVID overflow, the facility quickly turned into COVID-19 only as the need for safely moving positive but stable patients out of the hospital was of greater help. I was amazed looking at rows after rows of makeshift patient rooms that covered the floor and baffled at how this was all going to work. It was definitely trial and error and every new shift brought a new systematic way of doing things. But we

> all came together to make this facility work to the best of all of our abilities. The shifts were long, the care was complicated, the PPE was hot and in short supply, but we all bonded together to give what we could.

The patient population was just as varied as it was in a hospital. We had twenty year olds with no medical history, maxed out on oxygen therapy, barely able to walk a few steps outside their rooms without being short of breath who stayed with us for months, to older adults with multiple comorbidities who stayed a night or two, who walked out better than before. It was crazy to see how this virus was affecting everyone so differently, and how every day the medication and care changed as hospitals trialed different therapies.

I stayed with the company until early June when I learned I lost my job at the outpatient clinic but was hired for a new position at my old hospital in the OR. I stayed in contact with many from the



nursing staff and learned in the end of June, we discharged our last patient, and in the three months we all worked together we treated over 200 patients. It was so amazing to read how this makeshift field hospital had reached out to so many people and how this staff, from all different healthcare settings and even states, bonded together to make it all work and function like a real hospital. Through it all, even now working back in the hospital in the OR, I am so immensely proud of what we were able to accomplish and how necessary we were that our facility was the only field hospital to remain open. While I wish I could report that after the final discharge, the hospital was able to close down, it remains open and ready if there is a necessity. I hope that we never have to go back and that one day it can close the doors for good but it will take all of us together to make that happen.

As I look back at how I thought this year would turn out, I cannot believe this is where I have ended up. I have memories and experiences that will not leave me for a lifetime, but have helped me grow as an adult. I have learned to cope with that helplessness I felt so long ago through bonding with others who were in a similar situation. I also got the opportunity to see people from different walks of life come together to leave this world a little better and a little brighter. I know that every person worldwide was effected by this terrible pandemic and I never want to minimize the continued severity of the situation: past, present, and future. I hope we continue to remain safe and healthy and can continue to look for the positives even in these dark days.

Administrators and faculty spent the summer hoping and planning for the grand re-opening of St. Rose after months of closure. Following the strict guidelines put forth by the CDC, the New Jersey Board of Education and the Diocese of Trenton, a plan was developed, reviewed, tweaked and implemented to ensure that St. Rose students and staff could return to school safely and effectively. The hybrid plan allows for 75% of students to be in the building on any given day with those at home attending class virtually. Being flexible, creative and adaptive, St. Rose is able to offer more "in-person" class time than most other schools in the area, and allows our school community to thrive.

WORKSTATION DISINFECTION PROTOCOLS

### robotics

Now our students can compete as future engineers in local and national robotics competitions. We're excited to be able to showcase the skills and initiative of SRHS students!

To say it has been a challenging past 6 months is an understatement! Last year, and at a moment's notice, we had to go from 100% in person instruction to completely 100% virtual learning. However, we were already ahead of the curve regarding virtual learning because we already had a plan in place in the event that we exceeded our snow days. We also had transitioned to Google Classroom in the summer of 2019. During the previous summer, and in all of the school year's Professional Development Days, our staff was trained in using Google Classroom, Google Meet and many other applications related to Google Classroom. In fact, the day before we went to virtual learning, we had a full Professional Development Day devoted to maximizing Google Classroom and Meet for virtual learning. Not to boast, but I feel that our teachers were well equipped to seamlessly transition to the virtual model. I am not saying that it was perfect, and that there weren't hiccups, but we adjusted and made modifications as we went along.

This year we are on a hybrid model where, on a daily basis, we have 25% of the students home on virtual learning and 75% of students here in person. We are well prepared to teach both virtually and in person at the same time. Our goal was to return to some normalcy, and have the students back to in-person instruction. At this point, our students and staff have made the successful transition to the hybrid model. We are grateful and appreciative of all of the support from our parents and St. Rose community.

On another note, I am pleased that we have expanded our Performing Arts department offerings. We have added Orchestral Ensemble, Instrumental Pop and a Pipes and Drum band to our offerings. We are also forming a Robotics Team to complete in the FIRST Competition. The students are excited to have these additional opportunities. We have also expanded our Advance Placements (AP) courses offering for our students. Students who take these courses can have the opportunity to test in May and potentially receive college credit based on their performance on the AP tests. In addition, we have expanded our Project Acceleration course offerings. Beside the two semester courses in Education that were offered last year, we have added English and Irish Literature courses. Project Acceleration is a partnership with Seton Hall University where our teachers have been approved by Seton to teach a College level course at our school. Students who successfully complete the course will receive college credit from Seton Hall. The students can also potentially transfer those credits to another college.

I am extremely excited and happy about the growth of our academic offerings for our students. St. Rose High School will continue to evaluate our academic program to make sure that it meets the needs of our students.

### "Welcome to St. Rose High School, come on in!"

In my eight years as the Director of Admissions at St. Rose I have greeted hundreds, maybe even thousands, of families this way. So what happens when "come on in" is taken out of the equation?

For nearly a century St. Rose has stood out from the pack in many ways, but one of the biggest reasons was the true sense of family and community people feel when you walk through those big glass doors on Seventh Avenue. So while the doors remained locked this past spring, we had to adjust. St. Rose rolled out our first "Virtual Open House" in April, inviting prospective families to meet the community from the safety of their homes. Meetings that would have been in-person in years past, like our meet and greet with the athletic director Mr. Carey, and student interviews with admissions, were moved onto live streaming platforms. Some families even prefered the flexible style meetings and we will be able to weave some of these ideas into our future admissions program.

We continue to come up with innovative ideas to create personal connections with every prospective family, even if the venue is a living room and not the MAAC. While we are back on campus, big events like Fall Open House, that used to draw over 200 families, are now affected by safety concerns. We had a fully virtual Open House program over a month period in October, to take the place of one big event, and we're continuing to offer virtual presentations during November. Some presentations were pre-recorded, some are live, but they all have the goal of showing the best St. Rose has to offer.

St. Rose High School will adjust and make things even better as the year goes on. If the community has learned anything in the past century it is that perseverance is key, and in the words of John Maxwell "Change is inevitable, growth is optional". We have witnessed the unstoppable growth of this community over the past 97 years, and it will be an honor to see it for many years to come.
