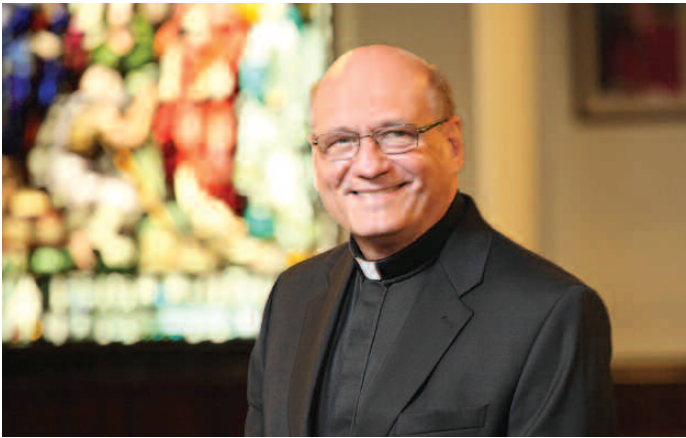

One of the projects this past summer was to replace the front steps of “The Red Brick Building” after years and years of use. The “Red Brick Building,” as it is commonly called, was built in 1921 under the pastorate of Rev. Msgr. William J. McConnell, the second pastor of St. Rose Parish.

It first began as the St. Rose Elementary School, and in 1923 St. Rose High School began there with 34 freshmen who became the first graduating class of the high school in 1927.

As I watched the construction crew take down the bricks, I remarked to the project manager, “Can you imagine the thousands and thousands of students who walked up and down those steps to go to their classrooms?” He said to me, “But Father, just think of how many thousands more will walk on these new steps when all the work is done?” I liked that very positive, hopeful statement that looks forward to the future of St. Rose High School!

Whether it’s the steps of “The Red Brick Building” or the steps of the present school building (built in 1957), our students enter St. Rose High School each day as they continue on their *Journey to Greatness* to learn, to grow, and to be challenged within our Catholic community. We are excited about all that is happening this new school year at St. Rose with the development of new academic programs and the start of our music program. Enjoy reading this 2018 Annual Report as we share with you some of the wonderful happenings at St. Rose. We have a tremendous faculty, staff and administration who are committed to our mission of providing quality Catholic education to our students.

Thank you for your generous support and for all you do for St. Rose High School! dear st. rose community,

During my second year as Principal of St. Rose High School, my appreciation for having the honor to serve our students and the entire St. Rose Community continues to grow. The culture of our school community inspires me daily to continue to enhance the proud history and tradition of excellence of St. Rose High School.

The values that we share as a Catholic high school are key to our continued success. A vibrant spiritual life at St. Rose includes daily communal prayer and religious studies, first Friday and religious holiday masses, special liturgies and participation in the sacraments. Father Chris Dayton, Parochial Vicar of St. Rose Parish, is with us daily and serves as spiritual advisor for our high school students.

Spirituality and a rigorous academic program are some of the reasons why St. Rose High School is the oldest secondary school in the Trenton Diocese. Our teachers challenge our students to be creative, explore, think and solve, and mediate with a thoughtful, caring and respectful mindset. Using state of the art technology, combined with effective, rigorous and relevant instruction, our faculty engages our students with meaningful lessons. The results are evident; 90% of our seniors are accepted to their college of first choice, 100% of our graduates are accepted to college and the 126 members of the Class of 2018 earned in excess of 25 million dollars in college scholarships.

Extracurricular programs supplement our spiritual and academic endeavors. Our students can explore their special interests, as there are over 40 clubs and activities available to them. St. Rose also features a full athletic program and our students compete on 24 varsity teams and an array of JV and freshman teams. During the 2017-2018 school year, St. Rose High School won State Championships in golf, bowling, and girls' basketball.

At St. Rose, we acknowledge the fast paced, changing world that we live in and the constant advances in technology. These changes have resulted in students learning differently than students had in the past. We have adapted to meet the changing needs of our students and to effectively facilitate their learning. We are proud of the technology that is available to our students. Some of our most recent upgrades include new computer labs, chromebooks issued to all

students and our classrooms equipped with the most updated Smart Boards.

Finally, what's new at St. Rose High School? Morning Convocation fosters a sense of community, enables us to share the achievements and accomplishments of our students and allows our students to display their talents with the entire school community. Also introduced this year is our Mini Med School, a Community and County Awareness Program, St. Rose Music Ensemble, St. Rose Theatre Company, live streaming of athletic contests in the MAAC and at our fields, a surfing and sailing team and an ethics team.

Our Learning Innovations team is busy planning for exciting changes to our academic program. A new schedule will be implemented during the 2019-2020 school year. The new schedule will allow our students to take four additional courses during their years at St. Rose. Our curriculum will be expanded to include an array of electives. We anxiously look forward to sharing these impactful programs within our St. Rose Community.

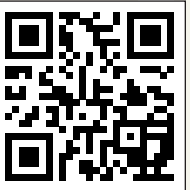

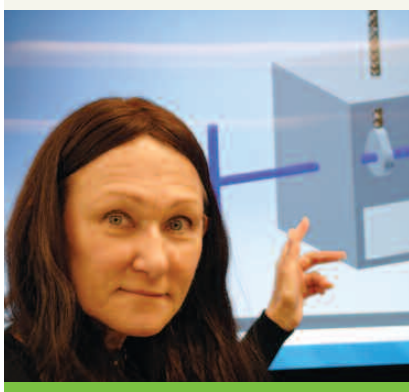
And there's so much more to come...

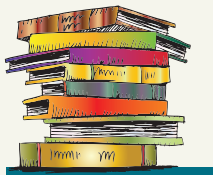
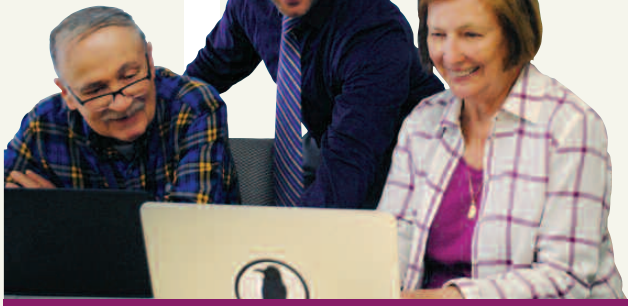
LIBRARY

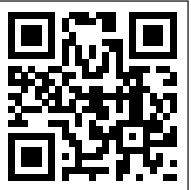

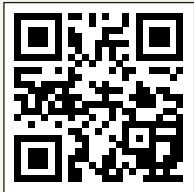




HUMANITIES

ENGLISH

Learning to make an argument, to express your viewpoint, and to articulate your feelings about a poem or novel – these are the vital life skills being taught to SRHS students. It may not be easy to get a freshman to dive deep into poetic symbolism or to organize his thoughts in a five paragraph essay, but under the careful and challenging tutelage of the English department, St. Rose students emerge as eloquent writers and journalists.



MATH

From the very first class, all the way to BC Calculus, St. Rose students are taught by an energetic and engaged faculty who understand that building a strong mathematical bedrock is key to advancement. Students are challenged to find more than just solutions to problems in textbooks; they are encouraged to develop grit, expand their mindset, and strive for a goal.

Our teachers know, value, and challenge our students every day.



SOCIAL STUDIES

They may be young, but the St. Rose Social Studies faculty knows the importance of studying the past and understanding how it influences the present and future. In these classes students integrate history with the world as we know it now, learn about the workings of government, and develop the critical thinking skills which will help them be involved in the future. It's not just dates and "past tense" to SRHS students, it's comprehending the reasons and the results of what's happened before that these dedicated teachers hope to instill in their students.

JADA WEEDON 2019

Jada attended GCI (Girls Career Institute) an all-girl experience at the Rutgers New Brunswick Campus at which 180 girls from all over New Jersey came together to form new connections, and attend informational seminars given by successful women from all different fields. The young women learned self-empowerment tips all while having time for fashion shows, skits, art shows, swimming, choir, Zumba and much more. Delegates to GCI were nominated by their school guidance departments and sponsored by their local womens' club.

All in all the experience was truly amazing because I walked in alone knowing no one, and left with 179 sisters, and life lessons that will stay with me forever.

AISLING HANNA, Religion teacher

Through the Anti-Defamation League's (ADL) *Bearing Witness* Advanced program, Aisling travelled to Israel with 19 fellow Catholic school educators from throughout the United States. The purpose of the trip was to learn more about Israel, the history of anti-Semitism, including the role of the Church during the Holocaust, recent changes in Catholic teachings on Jews and Judaism, issues of prejudice in contemporary society, and practical strategies for teaching students about the Holocaust and anti-Semitism, and to ultimately help Catholic-Jewish relations.

While in Israel Aisling was able to visit inspiring Christian and Jewish holy sites and incredible Israeli and Palestinian locations. The group travelled all over Israel visiting numerous areas, from the Golan



Heights in the north, to Masada in the south, to the beaches of Tel Aviv, and the vineyards of the Galilee as well as to the Dead Sea

and the River Jordan. They visited towns that had complex histories including a Kibbutz, a mosque, and the border area at Gaza.

Most inspiring for me was walking in the footsteps of Jesus in the Galilee, Nazareth and Jerusalem. I was privileged to be invited into a Jewish family's home in Jerusalem to celebrate Shabbat with them. We were given the wonderful opportunity to volunteer at Leket, Israel's enormous national food bank. We visited the Yad Vashem Memorial and met with interfaith experts, holocaust survivors and everyday Israelis, including Palestinians, Christians, Jews and Muslims alike who call the Holy Land home. The people were so nice, the food was awesome and the scenery so diverse for such a small country. It was an amazing and incredible experience that has inspired me as a person and most especially as a religion teacher, expanding my knowledge and love of the Holy Land and its complexities. I have a new understanding to bring back to my students at St. Rose.

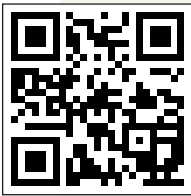
Over this summer, Jamie and Jenny traveled to Puerto Rico on a service trip with the group Global Works. They met twenty-two other teenagers from around the country and lived together for a week handing over their cell phones in order to focus on hurricane relief projects. They worked alongside community members who taught them how to mix cement by hand and together they successfully built a roof, laid a foundation, and built a floor. The women of the community cooked them a traditional Puerto Rican lunch each day, and they were able to practice their

Spanish by having conversations with the community members all throughout the meal times and at the worksites. They also traveled to a rainforest to aid with environmental issues from the hurricane which had turned the lush forest into a barren patch of trees. They met a woman named Thriti who built a 100-acre rainforest with her team over the course of many years. She inspired Jamie and Jenny with her incredible life story and simple perspective, and showed the girls how incredible the impact of one person can be. Jamie and Jenny will never forget her words: "If you don't wake up smiling, do something else with your life."



LEARNING ABOUT LEADERSHIP

At the end of the school year, 42 SRHS students and faculty attended the Lead U workshop at Chestnut Hill College in Pennsylvania. Lead U is a positive group of teaching artists who creatively engage, educate, and empower learners of all ages to find the leaders within themselves. At the workshop St. Rose students worked in groups with students from all over to understand their roles and to plan for the upcoming school year. THE WALKATHON

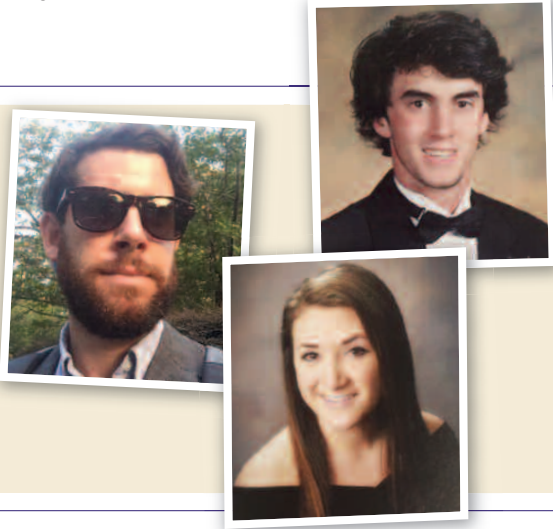

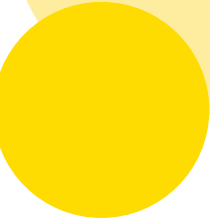

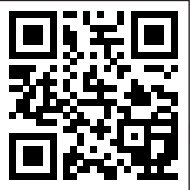
